

Transit Assistance Program (TAP)

The TAP program makes public transit more affordable for low-income residents in eastern Carver County.

Once qualified, riders can use a Metro Transit *Go-To card* that allows access to a \$1.00 fare for a full year. This transit service is available for residents requiring transit in Carver, Chanhassen, Chaska and Eden Prairie — locations in which SW Metro Transit drives. Riders can easily add money to their TAP card online through Metro Transit or using a mobile app.

4 Simple Steps to Enroll

#1 Eligibility — rider must present *one* of the following to verify low-income status:

- Free/Reduced Lunch Approved Letter
- State of MN EBT Card
- WIC ID Folder
- Metro HRA Family Report Summary
- HRA Payment Verification

#2 Show *one* form of Identification:

- Drivers License
- Photo ID
- Utility Bill with name and address
- **Bring the items (listed above) to one of the following transit stations**: (mail order forms are available online at www.metrotransit.org/tap-riders)
 - SouthWest Station, Eden Prairie (6:30 am—6:30 pm, Monday-Friday)
 - SouthWest Village, Carver (6 8:30 am, Tuesdays only)
 - East Creek, Chaska (6 —8:30 am, Wednesdays only)
 - Chanhassen Transit Station (6—8:30 am, Thursdays only)
- Add money to the Go-To Card and begin your \$1.00 fare transit. Note: families need to call Metro Transit for each ride and specify they are a TAP rider; all family members need their own Go-To TAP card; children under 5 ride for free; and students 13 years and older can ride the bus without a parent or guardian.
